



Call for papers for a special issue of *Child Indicators Research* on the subjective well-being of children under the age of 9 years old

We have been invited by the editors of *Child Indicators Research* to put together a special issue on eight year olds' well-being. The Children's Worlds survey included eight year olds in 15 countries. Most of the results that have been published or in press focus on the 10 and 12 year olds <http://www.isciweb.org/>. This call is an opportunity for scholars to focus on the eight year old sample. All kinds of papers are invited: conceptual, methodological, findings based on the survey or findings based on other studies of younger children - qualitative or quantitative. Comparative papers are particularly welcomed. The eight year old data is already available to participants in Children's Worlds and will be accessible on the website to all from November 2016. As some of the publications already in press include eight year olds you are encouraged to look at the list of papers on the Children's Worlds Website <http://www.isciweb.org/> before submitting a proposal.

Authors are invited to submit an abstract of 300 words outlining the content of their proposed paper by the end of 2016. Accepted papers will need to be delivered by end of May 2017 and will be published, subject to peer review, in the first issue of 2018.
