The Context of Colombia

Study in the **region of Antioquia > Colombia**, South América, which resembles Country conditions:

- Rural & urban
- Industrialized cities & small towns
- Diverse natural and cultural regions
- Multiethnic population

Contextualzing children's lives

Family and home context

- -Children live with parents and extensive family.
- -In the region 40% of households are women headed.
- -Parenting fluctuates between modern and traditional practices and varies according to the context (zone, ethnicity, economic status etc)

Social context and inequalities

-Principal vulnerabilities are related to poverty, armed conflict and violence, forced displacement, child labour, trafficking and drug consumption. However, families and community can also act as a protective factor.

Education system

- -Education provided by official and private institutions.
- -Net enrolment rates high for primary and preschool but drop for secondary and media. Some determinants are conflict, displacement and insecurity and requirement to work
- -Important differences in urban and rural areas.

Children rights

- -Colombia signed the Convention on the Rights of the Child and Children and Adolescents Law was established in 2006.
- -Different policy efforts for the recognition of child rights at national and local level.



- 98.3% of children were born in Colombia
- 27% lived in town city Medellín, capital of the department
- 73% lived in different regions of Antioquia.

Children are highly satisfied








Positive about Future

80% children (age 10 & 12) highly satisfied with their preparation for the future




More satisfied than happy

64% children (age 10 & 12) totally happy in the past two weeks




Mean age 10 & 12*


Satisfaction by life domains



- Self*, Possesions and Family life are the domains with higher satisfaction
- Friends, Attention paid by adults and Local area are the domains with less satisfaction
- Results for age 8 follow a similar pattern

Differences Age, Gender, Stratum





- There are small differences by gender except for School where Girls
 are importantly more satisfied than boys
- Differences by Age are higher, especially for friends, local area and attention: Younger children more satisfied in all aspects
- Significant differences by stratum: high stratum more satisfied in almost all areas

Money and possesions

→ Children are happy with things they have:

85% (age 8) 78% (age 10&12) very happy



Material Possesions

- More than 95% of children have clothes and television
- In a less extent (around 75%)
 computer at home and mobile.
- Lower percentages have books, music of their own and own room.

→ Children worry about family money

- 13% lack more than five out of nine items
- Children who lack more items are in general less satisfied


→ Family life highly valued

- ✓ Agree parents treat fairly: 79%
- Learn and have fun every day: more than 75%
- Less listened by parents

→Less satisfaction with local area

→ Safe at home, less safe outside



→ Few places for play and study inside and outside


Satisfied with friends

- Hit 2 or more times a month: 19%
- Excluded 2 or more times: 25%

Girls less satisfied with classmates but also less bullied

- Friends are nice: 46% (girls less in agreement).
- Enough friends: 62%
- Gather for having fun and talk and much less to study (never 32%)




9.2 Mean satisfaction what may happen later in life

→ Want to be recognize by family and kidness values



Children's Rights

→ Know about rights



→ But rights not respected by adults

→ Children Not listened by adults

- Parents listen and take into account: 69% total agree
- 3.5 and 8.8 means for satisfaction how they are listen by adults
- Teachers listen: 51% total agree

Highlights and questions

- High levels of satisfaction despite the situation of conflict and violence. Positive attitude or resignation?
- Important value to family as safe place Family as a factor of protection beyond tradition
- Older children less satisfied Lyfe cycle or external conditions?
- Although rights are well known, children are less satisfied with how they are listened by adults *Rights: at the discourse or at practice?*
- The environment and institutionality is not satisfying children inheritance of violence, a big challenge for policy and community
- Children are positive about the future and find family and kindness as important values, despite the conflict and cultures of money

Future research

- Other regions in Colombia
- More representation of rural area
- Participants outside the education system
- Inclusion of early childhood
- Discussion of results with children to adjust questions
- Participative action with children
