1. Sample and Weightings

The sample is representative for whole Germany, but 4 Federal States were selected for data collection:

North Rhine-Westphalia
Hesse
Thuringia
Baden Württemberg

Altogether 91 schools participated and 3158 students

Included in sample: 3009 students

Q8: 1056 ♀ 52 %

Q10: 1101 ♂ 48 %

Q12: 852

not born in Germany: 4.9%

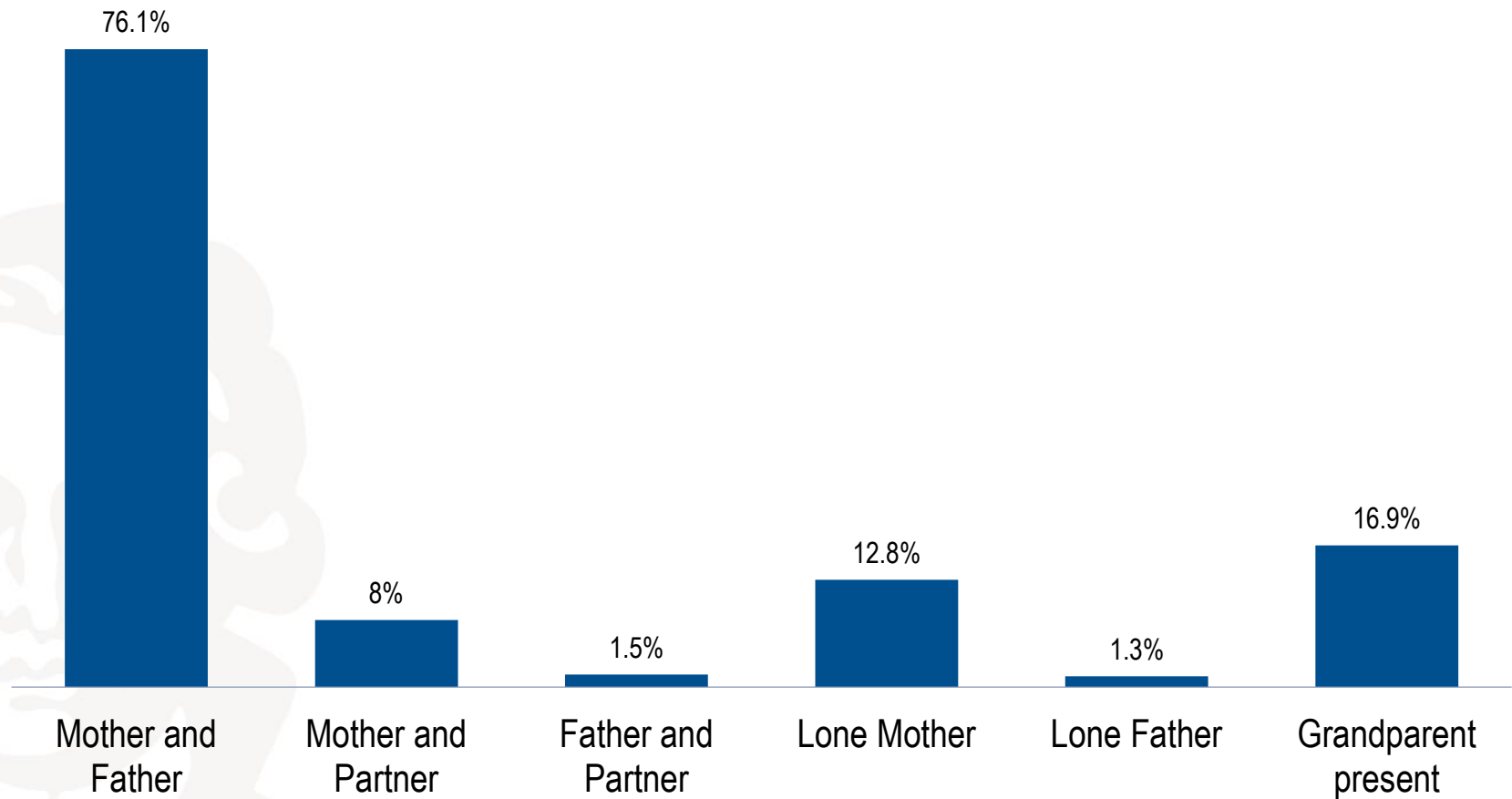
1st stratum: <i>part of the country</i>	West-Germany 88%				East-Germany 12%* * Overrepresentation

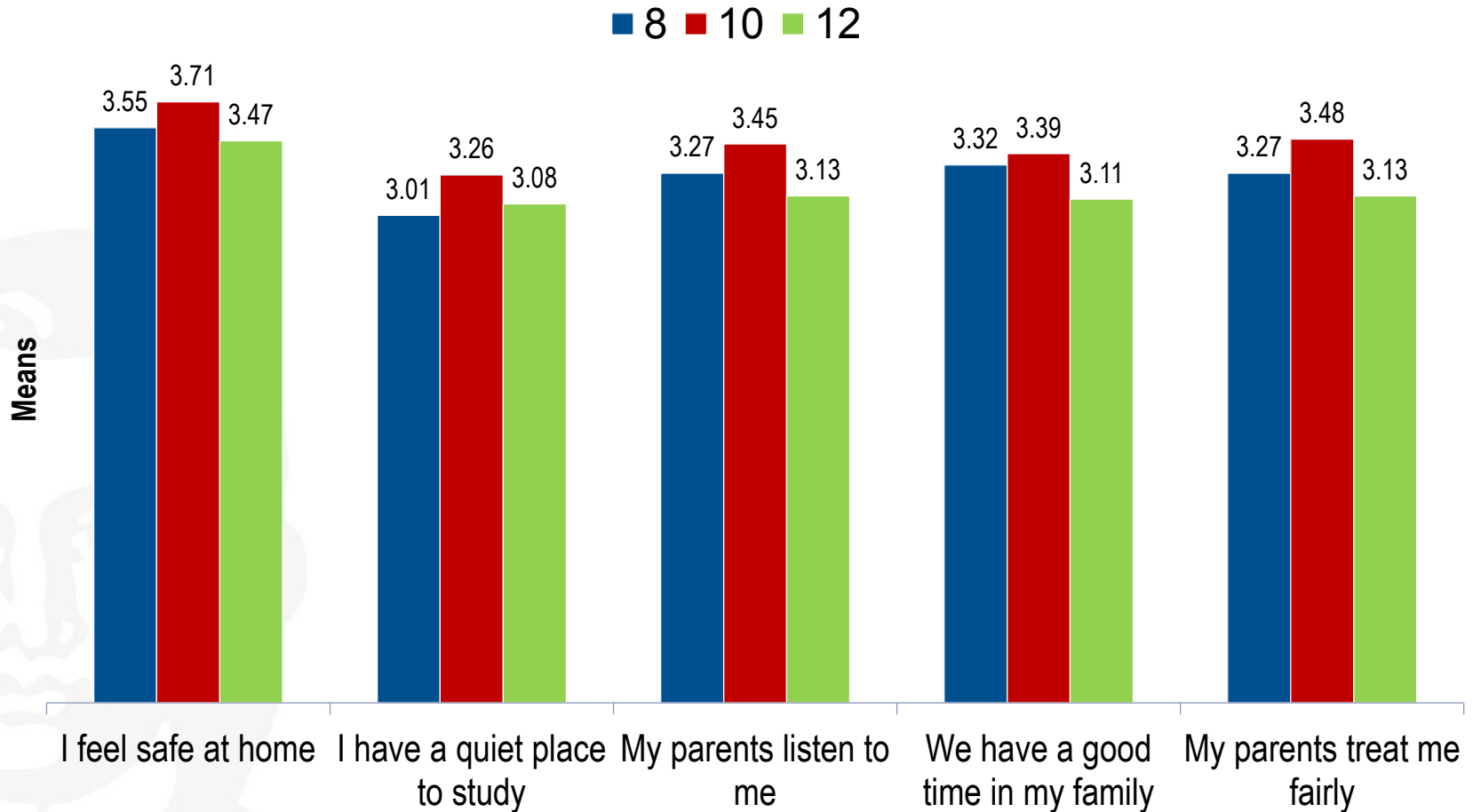
Your home and the people you live with

Family type in first home (Age groups 10,12)



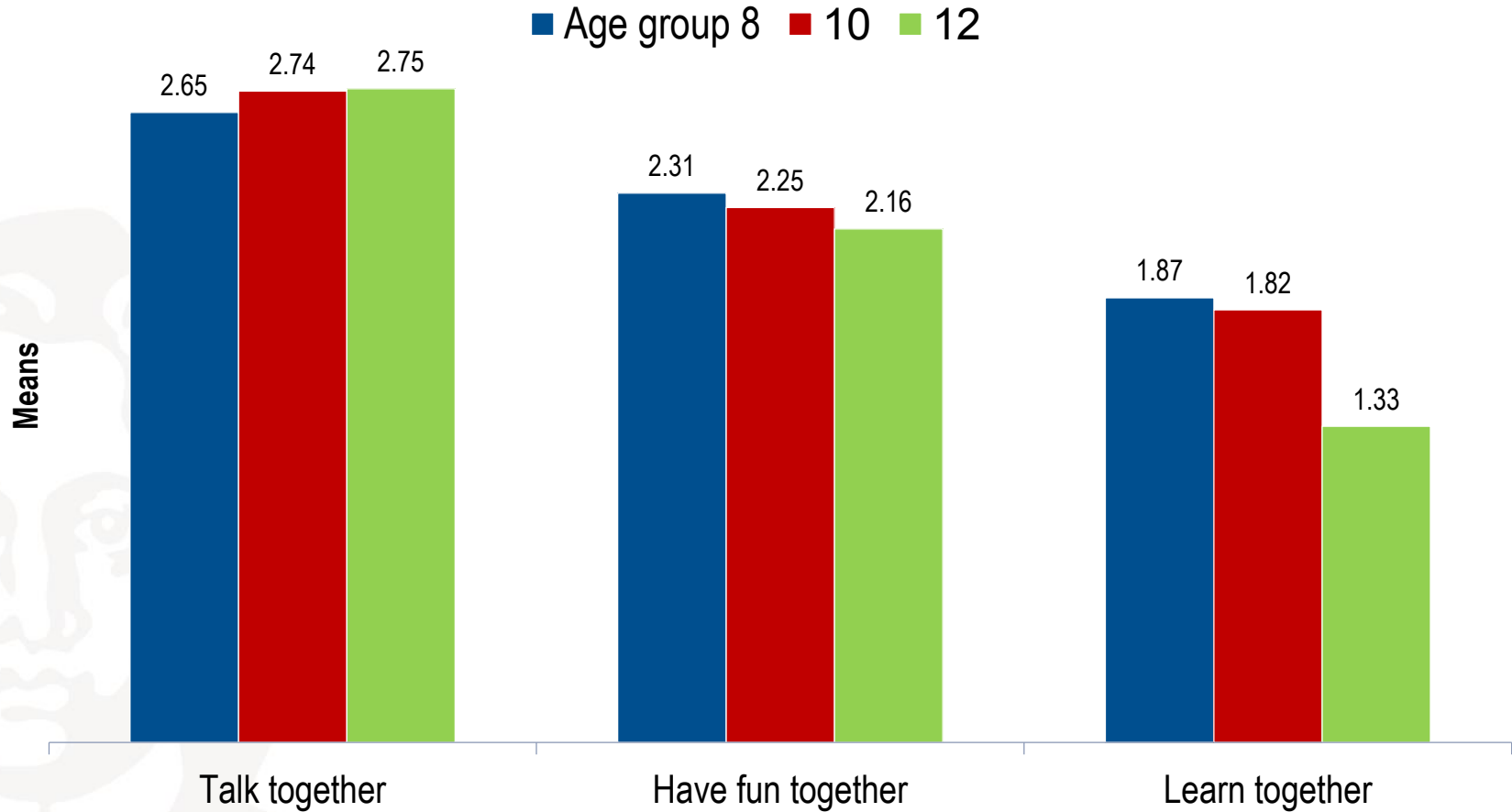

Frequency of spending time with family (All age groups) (Means 0-3)

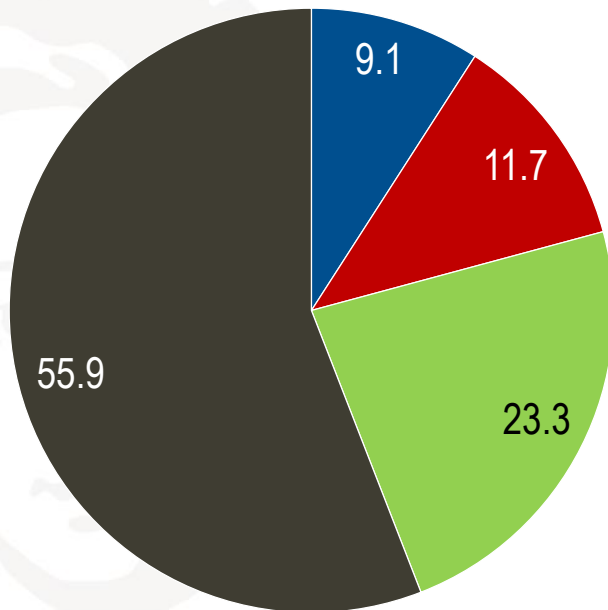

Frequency of getting pocket money (%)

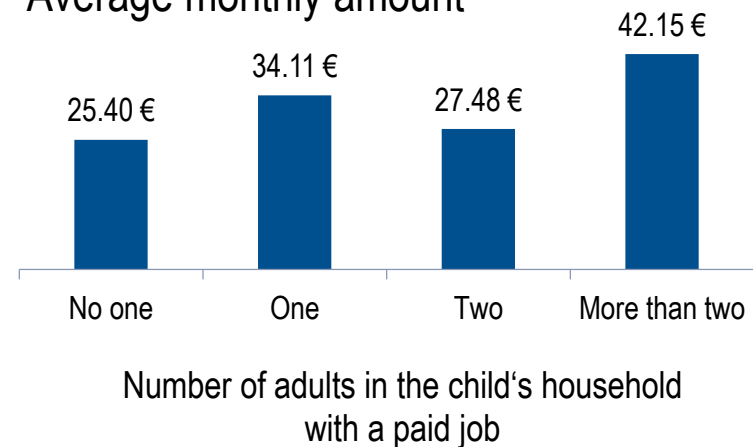

Average amount per month of children who get their pocket money regularly:

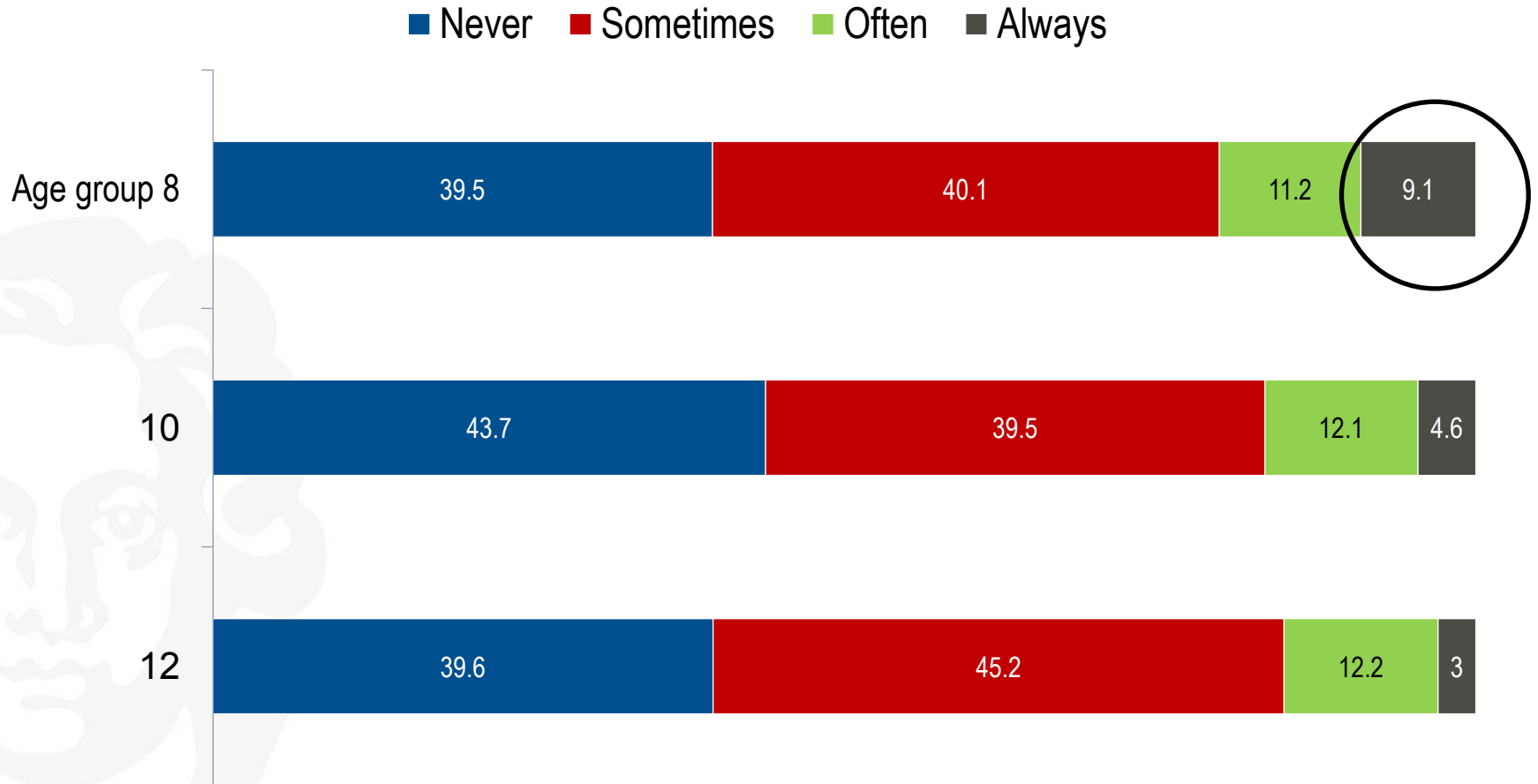

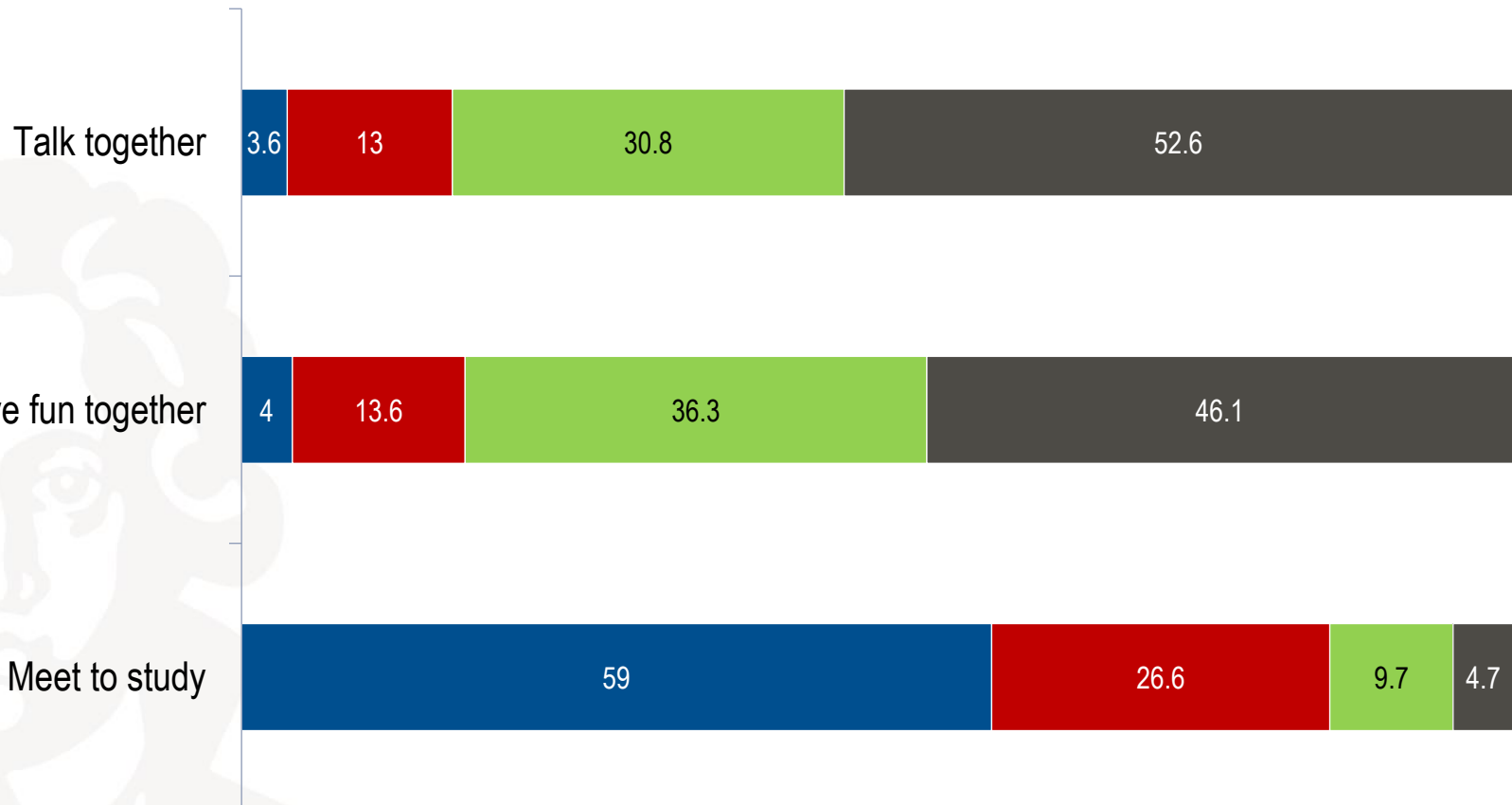
Frequency of worries about money the family has (%)



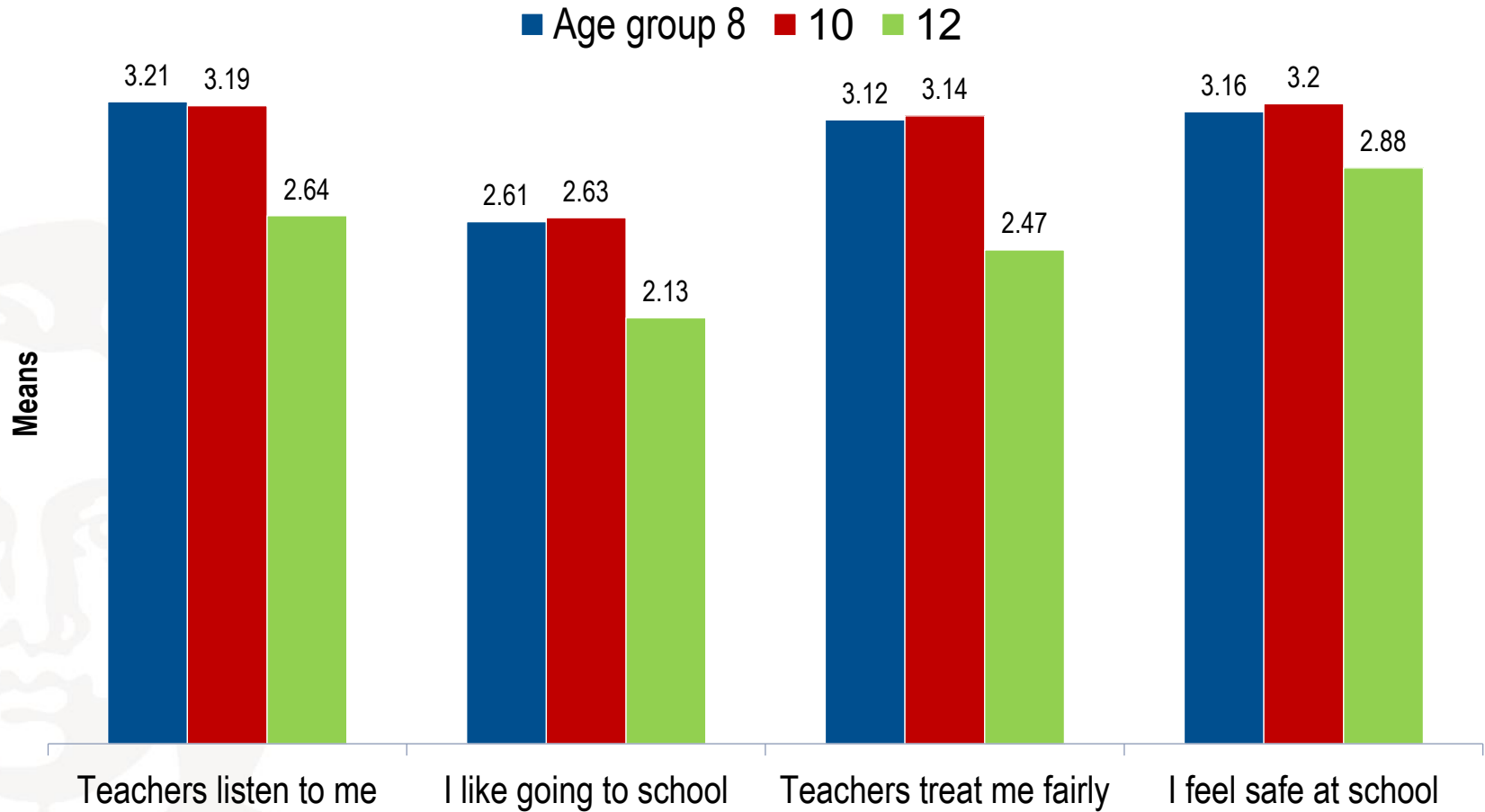

Frequency of activities with friends (All age groups) (%)

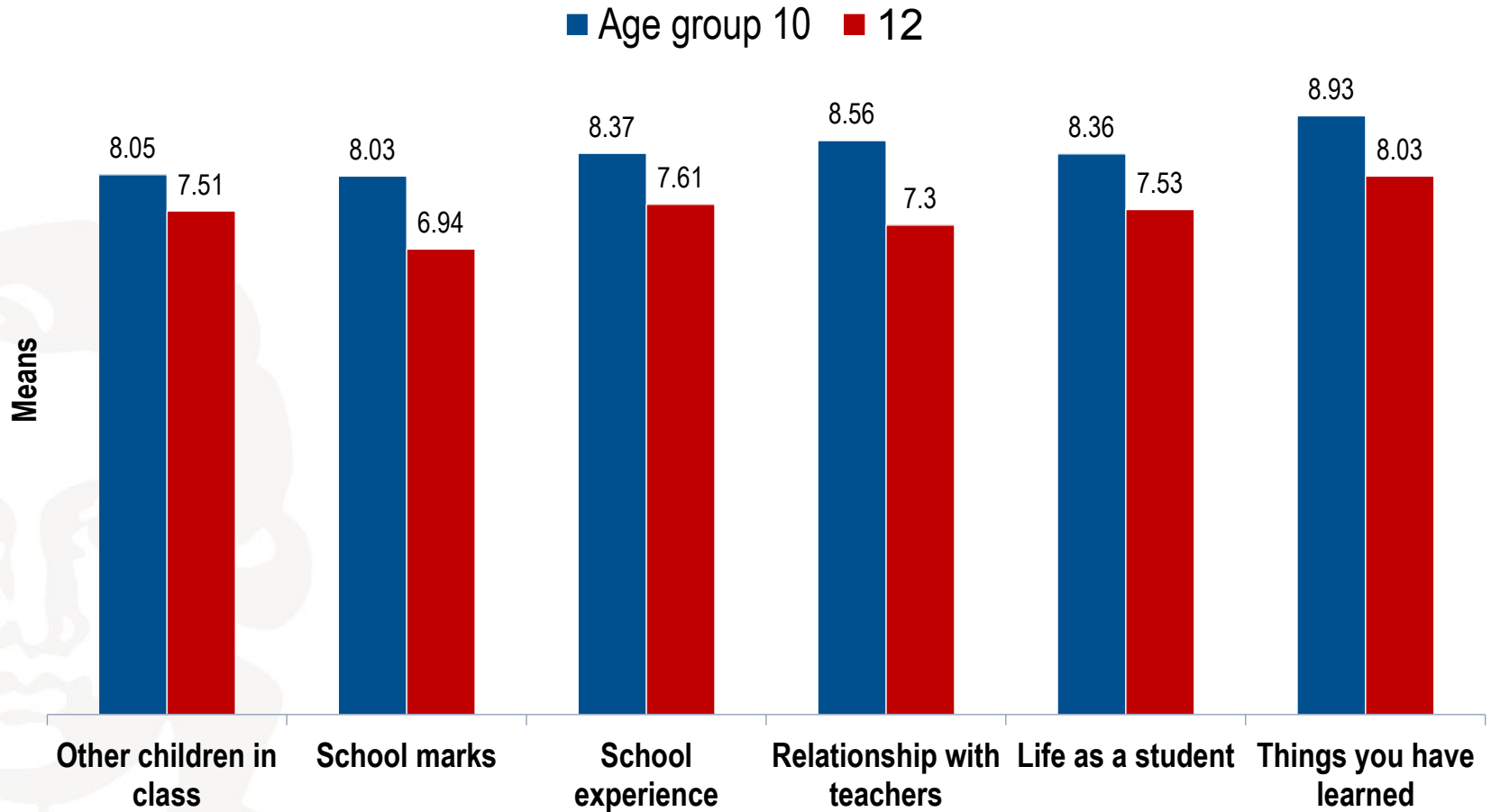

Agreement on school matters (All age groups) (Means 0-4)

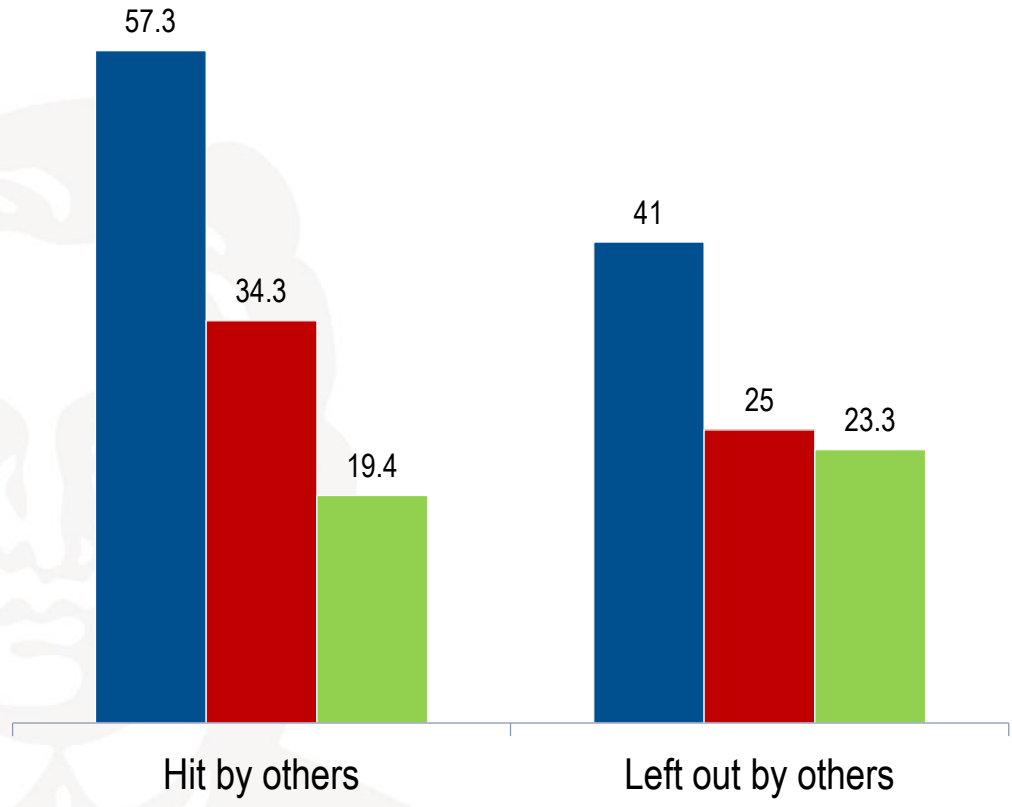


Satisfaction with school (Age groups 10, 12) (Means 0-10)

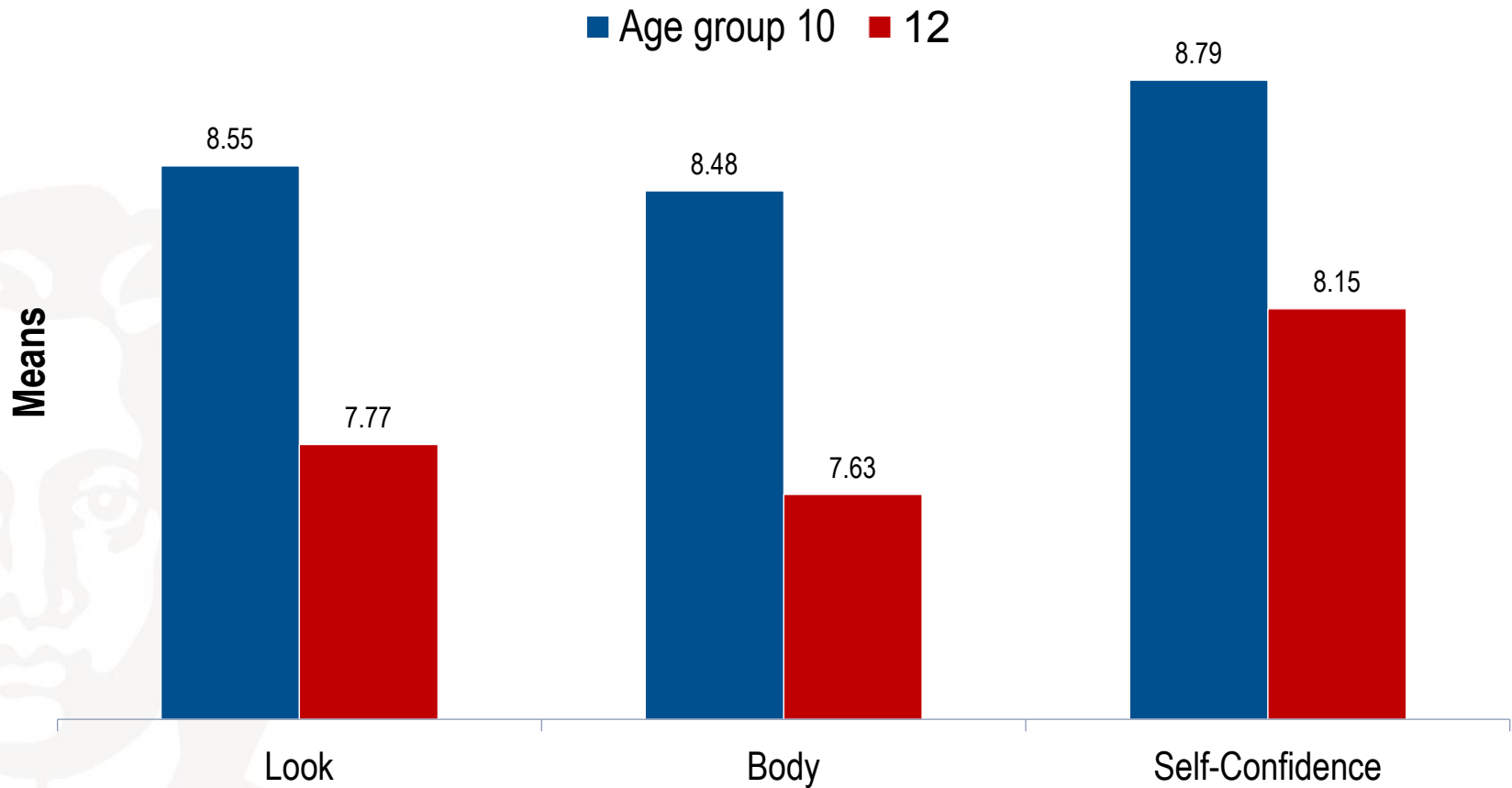


Number of students who experienced violence or bullying by peers (All age groups) (%)

■ Age group 8 ■ 10 ■ 12

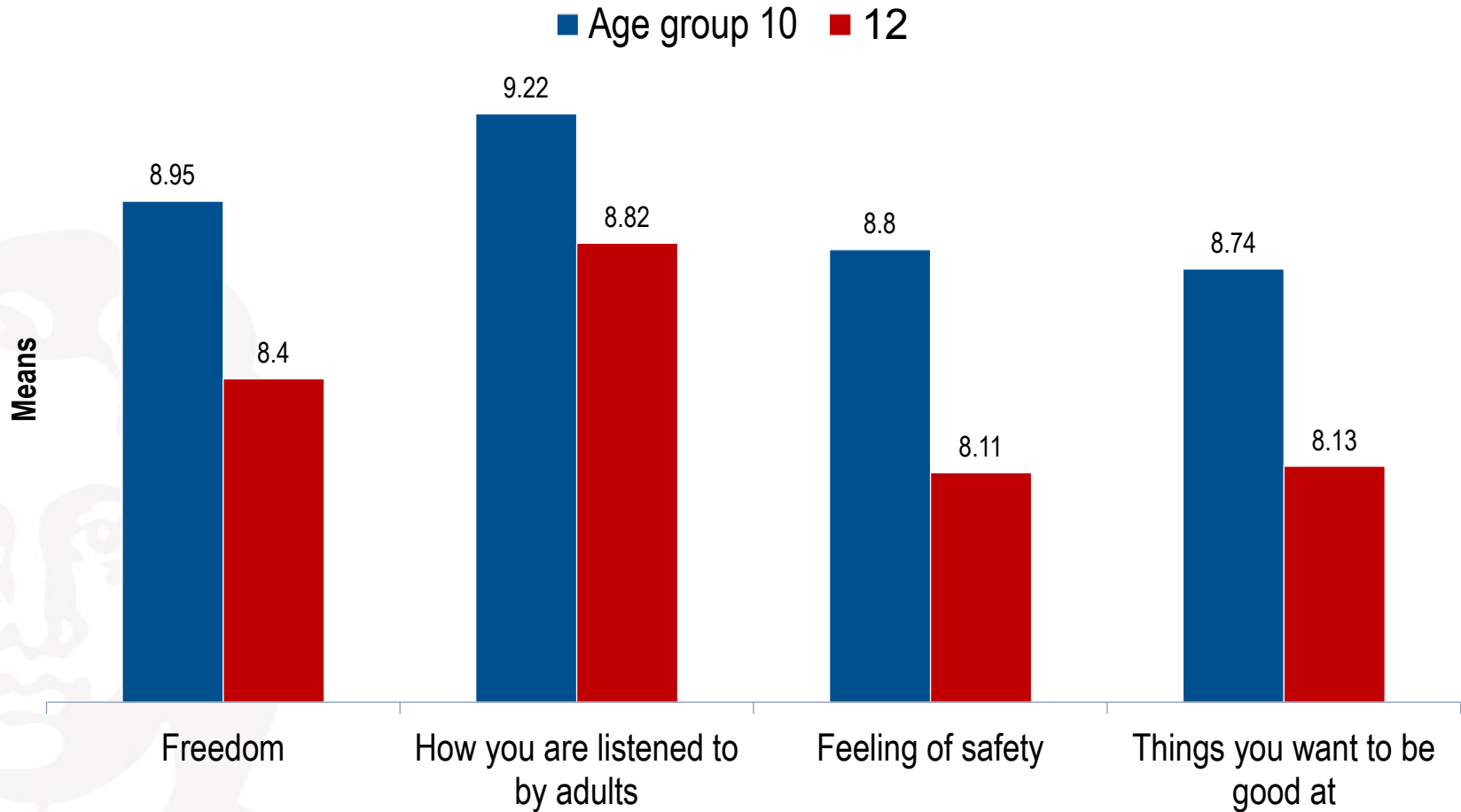


Satisfaction with self concept (Age groups 10, 12) (Means 0-10)

Satisfaction with life (Age groups 10, 12) (Means 0-10)

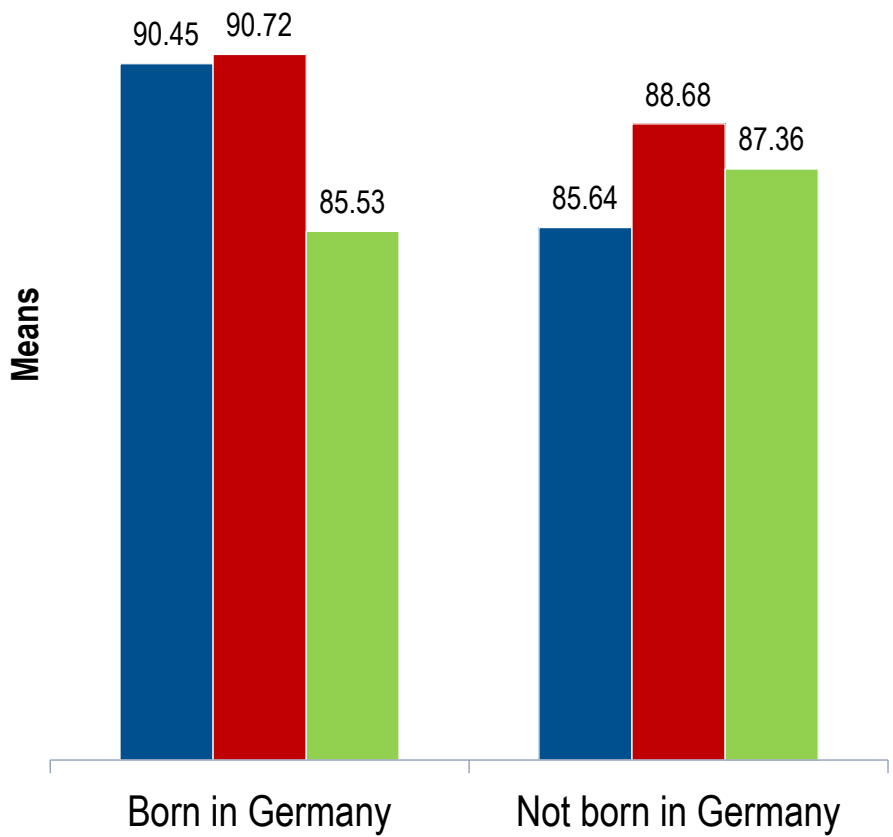
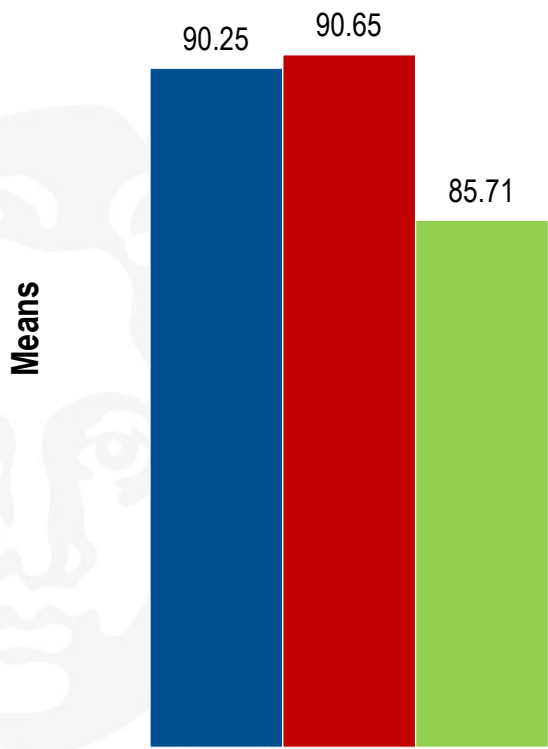


Overall Life Satisfaction – 100
